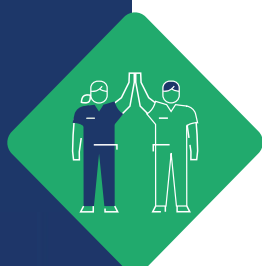

Great Climate

BC has one of the mildest climates in Canada and experiences four distinct seasons. Given the expansive geography of the province, temperature, average precipitation, and hours of sunshine can vary over short distances, but it's generally cooler in the north, warmer in the south and milder on the coast. Areas along the coastline are considered part of the world's temperate rainforest. BC does see a considerable amount of rain, but this allows for a unique and diverse ecosystem of old-growth forests and animal life native to the area. In the Interior and Northern regions of the province, wider variations in climate are more common, with more snowfall in the winters and gorgeous warm summers.
